Colonel Hill High School was established in 1964 in the campus of the Bangalore Friend-in-Need Society on Colonel Hill road and comprises two classroom blocks, an administration block, play ground and attendant facilities. The School was established to provide quality English medium education to successive generations of students.

The strength of the School grew steadily, by 1974, the school was permanently recognized as a Middle School with qualified Head Mistress. In 1976, Mrs. Jabeen was the Head Mistress, when the school was permitted to conduct the 7th Std Public Examination in their own

premises, this was a landmark for our School.

In 1983, the final move was made to upgrade the School to Secondary School (8th, 9th & 10th Std) after obtaining recognition from the Education Department. In 1984 Mrs. Krupalatha Dass was appointed as the 1st Principal of our High School. Today, the school strength has grown to 700 students.

Our School is the first SSLC stream school in the State to have both a full fledged Science Lab and a Computer Lab. Students now attend regular Computer Classes which is included in the regular curriculum from Std. III and above.
